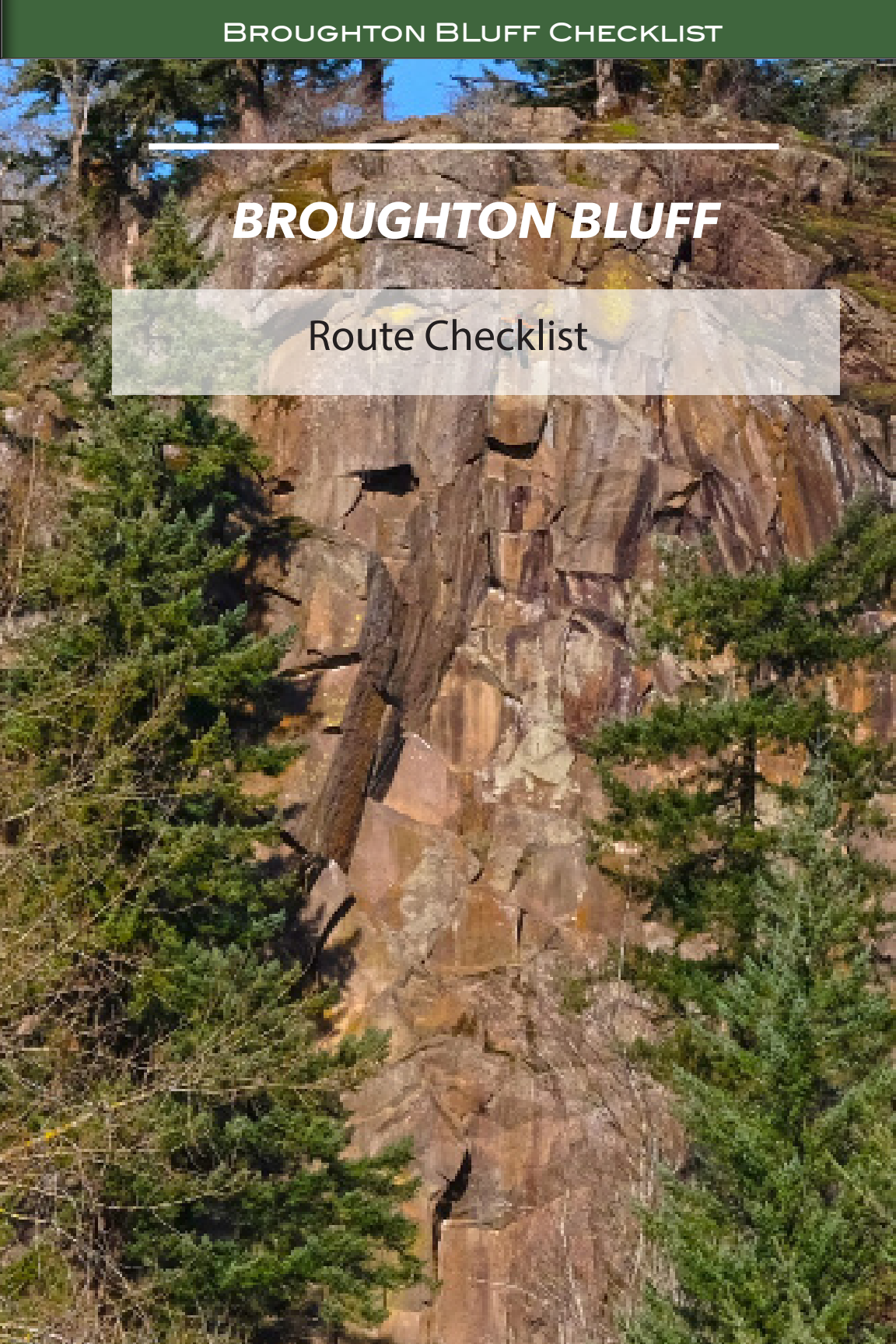

This area is not as popular as other parts of Broughton but it has some tall and excellent climbs. North Face is a good way to get away from the crowds, and late-day sun is found on the higher aspect of the face. Anchors are located at the terminations of most routes on this part of the cliff and it is easy to rap off most climbs.

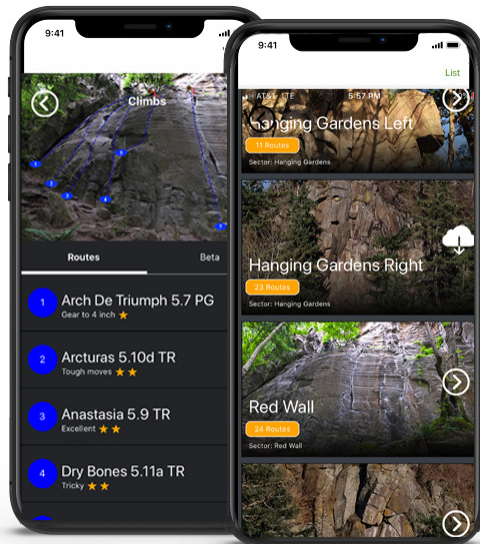
